Luke 1:26-38, John 3:16, Deuteronomy 6:5

Leviticus 19:18 & 1 Corinthians 13

Luke 1:26-38

<sup>26</sup>In the sixth month, the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a town in Galilee called Nazareth, <sup>27</sup>to a virgin engaged to a man named Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary. <sup>28</sup>And the angel came to her and said, "Greetings, favored woman! The Lord is with you. <sup>29</sup>But she was deeply troubled by this statement, wondering what kind of greeting this could be. <sup>30</sup>Then the angel told her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. <sup>31</sup>Now listen: You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you will name him Jesus. <sup>32</sup>He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give him the throne of his father David. <sup>33</sup>He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and his kingdom will have no end." <sup>34</sup>Mary asked the angel, "How can this be, since I have not had sexual relations with a man?" <sup>35</sup>The angel replied to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore, the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God. <sup>36</sup>And consider your relative Elizabeth—even she has conceived a son in her old age, and this is the sixth month for her who was called childless. <sup>37</sup>For nothing will be impossible with God." <sup>38</sup>"See, I am the Lord's servant," said Mary. "May it happen to me as you have said." Then the angel left her.

<sup>16</sup>For God loved the world in this way: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.

<sup>13</sup>If I speak human or angelic tongues but do not have love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. <sup>2</sup>If I have the gift of prophecy and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith so that I can move mountains but do not have love, I am nothing. <sup>3</sup>And if I give away all my possessions, and if I give over my body in order to boast but do not have love, I gain nothing. <sup>4</sup>Love is patient, love is kind. Love does not envy, is not boastful, is not arrogant, <sup>5</sup>is not rude, is not self-seeking, is not irritable, and does not keep a record of wrongs. <sup>6</sup>Love finds no joy in unrighteousness but rejoices in the truth. <sup>7</sup>It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. <sup>8</sup>Love never ends. But as for prophecies, they will come to an end; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will come to an end. <sup>9</sup>For we know in part, and we prophesy in part, <sup>10</sup>but when the perfect comes, the partial will come to an end. <sup>11</sup>When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put aside childish things. <sup>12</sup>For now we see only a reflection<sup>(s)</sup> as in a mirror, but then face to face. Now I know in part, but then I will know fully, as I am fully known. <sup>13</sup>Now these three remain: faith, hope, and love—but the greatest of these is love.
