## Happy Father's Day

**Luke 15:1-7; 20-32**

**15** All the tax collectors and sinners were approaching to listen to him. **2** And the Pharisees and scribes were complaining, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them." **3** So he told them this parable: **4** "What man among you, who has a hundred sheep and loses one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the open field and go after the lost one until he finds it? **5** When he has found it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders, **6** and coming home, he calls his friends and neighbors together, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, because I have found my lost sheep!' **7** I tell you, in the same way, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who don't need repentance. **20** So he got up and went to his father. But while the son was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion. He ran, threw his arms around his neck, and kissed him. **21** The son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight. I'm no longer worthy to be called your son.' **22** "But the father told his servants, 'Quick! Bring out the best robe and put it on him; put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. **23** Then bring the fattened calf and slaughter it, and let's celebrate with a feast, **24** because this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found!' So they began to celebrate. **25** "Now his older son was in the field; as he came near the house, he heard music and dancing. **26** So he summoned one of the servants, questioning what these things meant. **27** 'Your brother is here,' he told him, 'and your father has slaughtered the fattened calf because he has him back safe and sound.' **28** "Then he became angry and didn't want to go in. So his father came out and pleaded with him. **29** But he replied to his father, 'Look, I have been slaving many years for you, and I have never disobeyed your orders, yet you never gave me a goat so that I could celebrate with my friends. **30** But when this son of yours came, who has devoured your assets with prostitutes, you slaughtered the fattened calf for him.' **31** "'Son, he said to him, 'you are always with me, and everything I have is yours. **32** But we had to celebrate and rejoice, because this brother of yours was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.'"
